

God in You

Philippians 2:5-9 *5Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus: 6Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: 7But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: 8And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross. 9Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:*

You know when Jesus stood before that court of his religious Pharisaical peers who judged him as a mockery to justice, they asked Him, “Are you really the Son of G-d”. He finally answered, YES. And they were outraged, indignant, and angered to a violent degree. So it is today. The world really does not mind you being religious. In fact, even in the church today the religious can handle more religiosity in a bit of diverse religiosity. But when you stand and say, through the name of Jesus I can hear the voice of G-d, I can see the face of G-d, I can heal the sick. Raise the dead, and cast out devils. I can speak with the tongue of angels and see into the will of G-d. When you speak of tongues, prophecies and spiritual gifts, they are outraged and you are labeled a radical or a cult. They cannot stand that authority of your knowing who you are in G-d. They cannot stand the prophetic. They could not stand that Jesus claimed to not only be the prophetic spoke Word of God but also the fulfillment of those prophecies spoken by the prophets of old.

When you embrace and walk in the Kingdom authority G-d has chosen to delegate to you, you are not taking anything away from His majesty but adding to the glory of His name if in you is the mind of Christ, a humble servant obedient unto death and making of yourself no reputation.

You know they would have been okay if He had just excelled in the career path of a Pharisee and sought to sit in the seats of power in the temple. He could have even overthrown the governments of Rome and set up His own kingdom among men and sit on a throne as a King of men. But no, this man claimed to possess the power and authority of G-d.

Mark 7:24 *24And from thence he arose, and went into the borders of Tyre and Sidon, and entered into an house, and would have no man know it: but he could not be hid.* When you honestly and really have the power of G-d operating through your life you do not need a promotion manager, you do not need a marketing scheme, you do not have to tell others of what G-d is doing through you, you do not need others to spread the word, it cannot be hidden. If we as a church are truly the church, doing what the church is called to do, being what it called to be; if we are seeking the face of G-d and His favor is upon us, it cannot be hid. People will know about it. City officials will know about it. The entire city will know about it. Jesus had every intention of being hidden and just keeping to himself and being an obedient servant. But it could not be hidden.

John 16:14-31 *14He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew it unto you. 15All things that the Father hath are mine: therefore said I, that he shall take of mine, and shall shew it unto you. 16A little while, and ye shall not see me: and again, a little while, and ye shall see me, because I go to the Father. 17Then said some of his disciples among themselves, What is this that he saith unto us, A little while, and ye shall not see me: and again, a little while, and ye shall see me: and, Because I go to the Father? 18They said therefore, What is this that he saith, A little while? we cannot tell what he saith. 19Now Jesus knew that they were desirous to ask him, and said unto them, Do ye enquire among yourselves of that I said, A little while, and ye shall not see me: and again, a little while, and ye shall see me? 20Verily, verily, I say unto you, That ye shall weep and lament, but the world shall rejoice: and ye shall be sorrowful, but your sorrow shall be turned into joy. 21A woman when she is in travail hath sorrow, because her hour is come: but as soon as she is delivered of the child, she remembereth no more the anguish, for joy that a man is born into the world. 22And ye now*

*therefore have sorrow: but I will see you again, and **your heart shall rejoice, and your joy no man taketh from you.** 23And in that day ye shall ask me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give it you. 24Hitherto have ye asked nothing in my name: ask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full. 25These things have I spoken unto you in proverbs: but the time cometh, when I shall no more speak unto you in proverbs, but I shall shew you plainly of the Father. 26At that day ye shall ask in my name: and I say not unto you, that I will pray the Father for you: 27For the Father himself loveth you, because ye have loved me, and have believed that **I came out from God.** 28**I came forth from the Father,** and am come into the world: again, I leave the world, and go to the Father. 29His disciples said unto him, Lo, now speakest thou plainly, and speakest no proverb. 30Now are we sure that thou knowest all things, and needest not that any man should ask thee: by this **we believe that thou camest forth from God.** 31Jesus answered them, **Do ye now believe?***

Jesus is telling the disciples that something is about to be birthed inside of you. Right now you are in sorrow, travailing, and groaning in your spirits because you think I am leaving. But I tell you I shall return, I shall be with you, I shall be in you as I am in the Father and the Father is in Me. I shall come back and be fulfilled in your hearts as the Holy Spirit of G-d fills your hearts. I shall come and bring a true deliverance and you shall rejoice for the Kingdom of G-d has been birthed in you and your days of sorrow and separation from the glory of G-d and the authority of the Kingdom has ended. The day of rejoicing shall come that you are free from everything that does not bring life. You shall walk once again with G-d in you as He was in Adam.

The world needs to see in you and I victory not defeat. The world can watch five minutes of television, or walk out into the streets and see all the defeat they can handle. They do not need to look at the church and see a defeated people. When they look at us they should see a victorious people.

When the Word of G-d is birthed in you it should bring forth a joy and liberty like the world has never seen. In the beginning was the Word, the Word was God, was with God, and the Word came and fulfilled the joy of the Lord in you.

Jesus taught the disciples to pray, "**Thy Kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.**" Then I hear Christians say, "Well I want to know G-d's will for my life." The will of G-d for your life is that His Kingdom be birthed in you and the fruits of that Kingdom be evident in the earth through you NOW. In His Kingdom there is righteousness, peace, and joy. So in you on this earth now should there be righteousness, peace, and joy.

We say, "*Oh I am just walking through a valley, I am just going through a desert, G-d is trying to teach me something, just another opportunity to grow.*" Yet this may be true, even in the valley's your joy may be full. Even in the desert, rejoice for your deliverer has come. If you are having to be taught something it is because it is something you have failed to learn on your own. If you are having to go through a valley or a desert it is because you have left the presence of the Lord. I believe the only reason the Israelites had to be taken the long way around and through the desert is because they had failed to embrace all of who G-d was. They still had idols, selfishness, unrighteous thinking. Had they not had these things still in their hearts and lives G-d may have taken them straight into the promise land. Had they walked in the precepts and principles of G-d the law would not have had been given to judge them. I only need correct my children when they do wrong. If they are doing right I have no need to bring correction but instruction to continue and exceed the standard of right.

John 12:12-19 and **Matthew 21:1-16.** No longer was He to be hidden. Now it was made public that this was the Messiah. So has the hour cometh that the power of G-d in you be not hidden. So it was with Christ that the religious despised the power of G-d in Christ, so it will be with you. G-d is now in you if you are in Him. Where is G-d in the church? Today the church is not despised because of the power and authority of G-d evident but because of her hypocrisy and compromise. We need to be the church with the power of G-d evident.

II Corinthians 9:13-15 *13While by the experiment of this ministration they glorify God for your professed **subjection unto the gospel of Christ**, and for your liberal distribution unto them, and unto all men; 14And by their prayer for you, which long after you for the exceeding grace of **God in you**. 15Thanks be unto God for **his unspeakable gift**.*

We need to ask ourselves, “To what have I subjected myself? Have I subjected my flesh to sinfulness, have I subjected my soul to iniquity, have I subjected my spirit to disobedience and ungodliness?” We must ask, “Have I subjected myself to be obedient to the gospel of Christ?”

Folks, G-d is in you. Let the world see the unspeakable gift that dwells in you through the love of Christ, the power of the Holy Spirit and the truth of G-d's Word.
